

★ Sign-In/Sign-Out Procedures:

The parent or designated representative shall bring your child into the school and sign-in or out on the appropriate register with <u>initial</u> <u>signature and time notation</u>.

The school shall assume responsibility for your child after your child has been signed in and shall remain responsible until the child is signed out.

Any new or unfamiliar person will be asked to show a picture ID and his name will be checked in our authorization pick-up list on file for verification.

- ★ Please drop off your children by 8 o'clock.
- ★ Absences of <u>2 days or more</u> because of a communicable disease or sickness, will be

allowed to return <u>only with a physician's</u> written clearance.

Please call the preschool in the morning if your child will be absent or late.

★ SCHOOL UNIFORMS

Purple T-shirt with school logo with <u>Khaki-colored</u> elastic-waist pants, shorts or skirts must be worn with covered walking footgear. (no bare-feet). Velcro shoes rather than lace-up shoes is recommended for easy handling by the children. Uniforms are mandatory EXCEPT on Fridays "Aloha Friday" or special event days.

★ Extra Change of Clothing:

Bring the following to school: two sets of complete change of clothing, (shirts, shorts, socks and underwear) including a pair of slippers in a plastic bag <u>labeled with the</u> child's name.

Extra change of clothing does NOT have to be school uniform.

★ <u>Tuition</u>

Only credit card, certified check, personal check or money order will be accepted. **No Cash.** Check payable to **Jikoen Hongwanji Mission**.

Tuition for the following month is due by <u>the</u> <u>last working day of each month</u>.

A late penalty fee of 10% will be assessed and added to the monthly tuition which is non-

refundable, if not paid on the <u>first working day</u> of the month.

A \$20.00 charge will be assessed for all returned checks.

There will be no refunds or prorations for unforeseen emergency that may cause the school to close.

★ Tuition Receipt

Please note that we will issue a receipt for your monthly tuition three times starting August. You will receive three statements a year from August to December, January to May, and June to July.

For those who will need to have a receipt monthly, please contact the office at 808-845-7720. We will provide them upon request.


If you need additional receipt, we will charge **\$10 per receipt.**

This month, we will start learning the letters Mm, Nn, and Oo. We will also learn about and discuss Happy New Year and Community Helpers.


